St James

The elevated position of St James church in the centre of Cardington on what is believed to be an ancient henge monument gives it an impressive setting nestled among the surrounding hills with its tall crenelated tower visible from all approaches. Shropshire Hills AONB Pilgrim Trail

Located on the Welsh Marches border, the Shropshire Hills Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty is an ideal area to take in the landscape on a pilgrimage, as well the magnificent views along the way.
