

Church Stretton

St Laurence's is a 13th century, Grade I listed building, recently re-ordered, with historic features, including a carving of St Laurence holding an iron grid, on which he is said to have suffered martyrdom in 258 AD. Shropshire Hills AONB Pilgrim Trail

Located on the Welsh Marches border, the Shropshire Hills Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty is an ideal area to take in the landscape on a pilgrimage, as well the magnificent views along the way.
