

Walking along the Heart of Wales Line in Shropshire & Herefordshire



This 20 mile walk is a great way to immerse yourself in the undulating scenery on the Welsh Border where Herefordshire, Shropshire and Powys connect. Discover the churches embedded well within the landscape that have helped shape the history with some dating all the way back to the 1400s.

- Taking the Heart of Wales Trainline from Craven Arms to Knighton.
- A moderate 20 mile walk through beautiful scenery on the Welsh Border.
- The walk follows part of the Shropshire Way and Herefordshire Trail
- The trail takes in four historic churches situated in Herefordshire and Shropshire, all with their own stories to tell with an opportunity to find out more on arrival.
