



Discover Churches

Update: October 05, 2021

Starting and finishing in Bishops Castle, this trail takes in the quieter roads and paths to cycle around the Long Mynd visiting a variety of churches along the way.

Travelling from Bishops Castle to Wentor Church cycling via More Church and Norbury.

More, St Peter's

is situated on a raised Circlur Churchyard that indicates a pre-Christian origin. The C12th Tower with its C17th double pyramid belfry containing three bells dated 1612, 1617 & 1624. The More family of Linley Hall, renowned for its Mayflower and USA connection

and Robert More's (1703 - 1780) great friendship with Linnaeus, the world famous botanist.

Wentor, St Michael and All Angels

dates from Norman times, but substantially restored in 1886. Wentor Church occupies its hilltop setting in the manner of a Tuscan village, offering extensive views over its hinterland. Inside, the nave displays colourful hand embroidered knellers, whilst the 'hurricane tombstone' commemorates a ferocious blizzard which wiped out an entire family.
